

## **What your United Way contribution can do . . .**

### **Less than \$1 per week (\$50 a year) provides**

- Medical supplies for a terminally ill cancer patient.
- Dues sponsorship for one 4-H Clover Kid or 2 4-H Club members, based on financial need, to participate in the world's largest youth-serving organization.
- One food basket for a family.
- Transportation to Columbia for two families' medical needs.
- Training for 5-6 volunteers who assist area seniors with the Missouri Property Tax Credits that last year returned \$95,970 to area seniors.
- Enough supplies to teach 48 young adults the skills they need to run a safe, successful babysitting business.
- Swimming lessons for a child who cannot afford them.
- Groceries for a family of four for one week in the shelter.
- 620 disposable meal trays to be used to provide home-delivered meals to the frail and disabled homebound clients in need of a hot nutritious meal. \$50 would provide about one week of needed trays.
- Two camperships for two Cub Scouts to attend Cub Scout Day Camp.
- Five girls with the Girl Scout experience!

### **Less than \$2 per week (\$100 a year) provides**

- Sponsorship for one 4-H member to attend 4-H camp, including bus transportation (for financial need and award recipients).
- Groceries for a week for a family of three who have been displaced from their home because of storm damage.
- Pain medication for a terminally ill cancer patient.
- A week of summer day camp for a child who might otherwise spend the day at home alone.
- 454 cartons of milk that is delivered to the homebound clients' homes along with their home-delivered meals. \$100 would provide milk for three days.
- 8 pairs of shoes for children in the shelter.
- One campership for a Boy Scout to attend summer camp.
- RSVP with enough printing supplies to assist Medicare Part D beneficiaries with their questions and comparisons for one year.
- Meat products for the food pantry.
- Training and resources for Girl Scout leaders to help girls grow strong.

### **Less than \$5 per week (\$250 a year) provides**

- Sponsorship for one outstanding 4-H member to learn about careers, global cultures and service learning at the Kansas City 4-H Global Conference.
- A meal reimbursement for one RSVP van driver on the day they deliver volunteers to and from their volunteer sites.
- A one-year YMCA membership for child, including after school care every day.
- 102 hot nutritious meals for the frail and disabled homebound clients – about 80% of the meals delivered in one day.

- Accident and Sickness Insurance for a Cub Scout Pack – both youth members and leaders.
- A once-in-a-lifetime experience for a young girl to go on a trip, an opportunity she may never have if not through Girl Scouts.
- Year-long bereavement care to a surviving widow of a Hospice patient in rural northeast Missouri.
- One family with assistance in turning their electricity back on.
- Transportation by train or bus for two people to be with a dying relative.
- Rent deposit for one family to move into a safe living environment.

**Less than \$10 per week (\$500 a year) provides**

- Support for nine 4-H Camp Counselors to learn and serve in a leadership role, serving as a positive role model for nearly 100 youth at 4-H Camp.
- One month of delivery costs of providing meals for 65 homebound individuals who are in need of home-delivered meals.
- Transportation for 20 clients for work or medical visits.
- Camp Mahaska for a week for 4 children.
- Three nights in the safehouse for a family of four.
- A manikin to teach life-saving CPR to many of the nearly 80,000 residents of our service area.
- A one-year YMCA membership for an adult with disabilities, including all fitness classes.
- Two new summer camp tents.
- One RSVP volunteer maximum mileage reimbursement to and from their volunteer site for one year.
- Once-in-a-lifetime camping experiences for troops.

**Less than \$25 per week(\$1000 a year) provides**

- Raw food to prepare 667 meals for those in need of a well balanced nutritious meal. \$1000 would provide nearly one week of raw food that is needed for meals for the frail and disabled homebound clients of our community.
- Utility assistance for 6 families.
- Sponsorship for one award-winning 4-H member to attend the 4-H Citizenship Washington Focus in our nation's Capitol.
- 300 RSVP volunteers with liability, accident, and excess auto insurance while volunteering.
- Shelter and clothing for a family of four who lost everything in a fire.
- Two first-year summer camp staff members.
- Six nights in the safehouse for a family of four.
- Medical equipment for a terminally ill cancer patient.
