AGREEMENT

The person who signs this agreement represents that he/she is authorized to enter into this agreement on behalf of both exhibitor and the owner of entered dog. In consideration of acceptance of this entry:

1.1 As used here NADAC means North American Dog Agility Council, its members, officers, directors, employees, show chairs, show committees and agents. As used here Gulf Coast Chihuahua Club means its members, officers, directors, employees, show chairs, show committees and agents.

1.2 Exhibitor/owner, agree to abide by the rules and regulations of NADAC and any other rules and regulations appearing in the premium for this event.

1.3 Exhibitor/owner certify that the entered dog is not a hazard to persons, dogs or property and that the entered dog's rabies vaccination is current in accordance with the requirement of the state in which the dog resides.

1.4 Exhibitor/owner acknowledge all hazards presented by the event and the event premises, including but not limited to, the condition of the floors, stairways, halls, lighting, security measures or lack of, electrical appliances, fitting, show rings, parking areas and the presence of unfamiliar animals and people; exhibitor and owner assume the risk of any harm arising from these.

1.5 Exhibitor/owner release NADAC (Including NADAC officers directors, employees and members), Gulf Coast Chihuahua Club, Inc., The Jackson County Multi-Purpose Complex and the city of Vancleave, MS Rec and Parks and will defend them and hold them harmless from all present and future loss, injury, damage, claims, demands and liabilities involving the entered dog, the event or event premises. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing hold harmless provisions, exhibitor/owner hereby specifically assume sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expenses (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damages because of bodily injuries, including death, at any time in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, howsoever such injury or death may be caused and whether or not the same may have been caused or may have been alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents or any other persons.

1.6 This trial will be held under the current rules and regulations of NADAC. Exhibitor Handbooks are available free of charge by downloading from NADAC's web site at www.nadac.com.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of NADAC rules and regulations, and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of this trial.

- All dogs must be on leash when not competing in the ring.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, acts of God, public emergency, and act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. In the event the trial cannot be held due to an “act of God” a rain date coupon will be issued for use at the next trial we hold.
- There will be no refunds for entries withdrawn after the closing date or in the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless of the reason for such dismissal. Refunds will be given for bitches that come into season after closing date or for an injured dog, providing a Veterinarian certificate is submitted. There will be a Handling Charge of \$10.00 per dog
- Checks not honored by the bank do not constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a \$25.00 service charge for bank returned checks.

***** Dogs must be registered** and have a valid registration number before entries will be accepted.

Through submission of their entry, the exhibitors acknowledge they are familiar with the rules in the current Exhibitors Handbook. THE MANAGEMENT will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor whether the result was by accident or any other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this event is in the care and custody and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Show Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of fees paid will be made.

Classes will run small to tall – Elite, Open, Novice

IMPORTANT. Please check your dog's NADAC registration number on your trial confirmation as soon as you receive it; also, please check the copy of the results posted at the trial. You should report any errors to the Trial Secretary immediately.

NADAC records trial results as they are submitted by the host clubs/groups. The individual trial results submitted by the club are uploaded to the files section of the NADACAgility@yahoo.com list within two weeks after the NADAC office receives them from the club. The trial results will remain on the list for at least thirty (30) days. Please accept the responsibility to review those results, and check that your registration number and qualifying points, as reported by the club, are correct. You can join the <http://www.NADACAgility@yahoo.com> list and set your settings to "no mail". You will be able to view trial results and check for any possible discrepancies, without receiving list mail. If you find an error in the reporting of your dog's qualifying points or registration number, please contact the host club. The host club is responsible for correcting any errors and informing NADAC.

Levels. Points earned at a higher level of a class, prior to the completion of the lower level title, will not be banked by NADAC for future use. If a dog earns points in a level of a class that they are not eligible to title in, those points will not be added to the dog's records.

PROFICIENT/SKILLED CATEGORIES

Each class will be split into two categories, **Proficient** and **Skilled**. In the Skilled Category, dogs must jump 4" lower than indicated by the current jump height table. (No dog may jump less than 4").

Dogs entered in the Skilled Category may incur 5 or fewer faults, (course/time) and earn a 5 pt. qualifying round in the Regular Agility class.

In the Proficient category a qualifying round must be clean; no course faults, and no time faults.

Entries must be for either Skilled or Proficient for entire weekend.

Non-Jumping classes – Veteran Handler:

Handlers aged 60 yrs. or older may opt to enter the non-jumping classes as a Veteran Handler and receive 10% more standard course time. This division is for handlers only.

Jump Heights

Dogs entered in the Proficient Category must jump at the minimum jump height specified by the following table. As of January 1, 2009, when entering the Skilled Category, all dogs must take a 4" jump height reduction from their Proficient, Standard Division jump height. Points earned in the proficient/skilled levels can still be combined for titles in the Novice/Open Levels.

Measuring:

All dogs entered in the Proficient category, Standard Division for Novice, Open or Elite jumping 4", 8", 12" or 16" are required to be measured. Dogs jumping 20" or 20+ are not required to be measured, nor are Veteran or JH dogs that jump 16", nor are Skilled category dogs at any jump height. An exhibitor may request to have their dog measured to determine if the dog should be entered in 20" or 20+, but no height card will be issued for any dog jumping 20" or 20+.

Dogs with permanent height cards need not be measured.

Trial Equipment:

Rubber matted A-Frame and Dog Walk, tunnels, weaves, non-winged jumps and hoops.

Class changes and Move-ups:

Move-ups for Friday, October 30, 2009 will be accepted until 6:00 pm, October 28, 2009 by email or phone call to the trial secretary. Day to day move-ups will be accepted the rest of the weekend.

Awards:

First through fourth place will be awarded in each jump height for all classes with the exception of Chances, which is a Pass/Fail class. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded for those achieving a qualifying score. A titling ribbon will be awarded to any dog earning a title. All awards must be picked up as GCCC will not mail any ribbons.
